- She attended university in India and returned home after earning her degree in economics.
- She became mayor of Maidan Shahr in 2018 at the age of 26.
- As a women's rights activist, she used her platform to inspire other women.



Zarifa Ghafari


- Soon after becoming mayor, Zarifa faced numerous death threats from the Taliban. She survived three assassination attempts.
- As mayor, she introduced anti-litter campaigns as well as became a role model for the women around her.
- In 2020, she saw her father being murdered by gunman in front of their home.
- In 2021, Zarifa fled the country with her family after the Taliban took control of Afghanistan's government.

October-December


President Bush authorizes the bombing of Afghanistan in response to the 9/11 attacks. The Taliban collapses and Al-Qaeda retreats.

June

Pres. Obama agrees to withdraw a third of troops by 2012 due to political pressure; however, the relationship between the countries is hostile.

July

All U.S. forces withdraw from Afghanistan as a result of the Doha Agreement under the Trump administration.
